

How to write a Submission on the Therapeutic Products Bill

In November 2022, parliament introduced the Therapeutic Products Bill, intended to replace the Medicines Act 1981 and the Dietary Supplements Regulations 1985. We want to make sure that our whānau understand what this could mean, and how you or your organisation can make a submission on the Therapeutic Products Bill. Rongoā Māori hasn't been defined in the Bill, and this poses a number of concerns for practitioners and whānau.



Our whānau,hapu and iwi need your help

The Therapeutic Products Bill seeks to regulate Rongoā Māori. Our Rongoā Māori practitioners haven't been engaged with yet and we know how much this will affect any whānau that uses Rongoā Māori.

Despite there being a 10 year work plan no proper and meaningful engagement with practitioners and Rongoā Māori experts has happened. A board or one person does not speak for and behalf of whānau, hapu and iwi.



Decision-making time

Submissions for the Therapeutic Products Bill close on Wednesday 15th February, so we only have a little bit of time left to let parliament know how this Bill is going to affect us. Anyone and everyone can make a submission, and we want to make sure that our whānau and people know what's going on, and to use their voice to let parliament know what they like, dislike or want to change about this Bill.



Sharing with government

Once the select committee has finished going through Submissions and receiving advice, they share their decision and recommendations with parliament.
